Sports Day



The Nursery Sports will take place in the afternoon of 6th June. Both am and pm sessions will have their sports together. All Nursery children have been invited to join the rest of the school for a picnic at 12.15 pm, prior to the sports starting at 1 pm.

Following the sports, you will be able to take your child to the summer fair.

Please note that there will be no morning nursery session on this day.

Summer Trip

The Nursery summer trip has been arranged for Friday 7th June. We will be joining Corinne, the Countryside Ranger at Rosemarkie beach to participate in a mini-beast hunt. The bus will leave the school at 9.15 am and will return by 12 noon. All children are invited whether or not they usually attend on a Friday. Children should bring a packed lunch/snack. As we will be outdoors, please ensure your child has appropriate clothing such as a waterproof jacket and wellies. As we are hoping for sunshine, we ask that sun cream is provided too and applied before arriving at Nurery. We would like to ask for parent volunteers to help out on this trip. For safety reasons, we need one adult for every two children. If we do not get enough volunteers, we will not be able to go on our trip. A permission slip will be issued nearer the time.



Please note that there will be no afternoon nursery session.

On 10th June, people from the SSPCA will be visiting the school. They will be visiting the Nursery children in the morning and in the afternoon. We are very much looking forward to finding out about what their job entails.

Transition Activities

To allow for all of the Nursery 4 children who are going into Primary One after the summer holidays to meet each other, we will have a change in session times for some children. On Monday 10th June and Friday 21st June, all Nursery 4 children are asked to come for a morning session (8.50 am - 11.20 am). This will allow the children develop some familiarity with each other and Mrs Williams/Mrs MacIver as a class. The Buddies will also take the children out for morning break. The children can bring a play-piece/snack with them or they can bring money to buy toast and a drink at the canteen.

All Nursery 3 children should come to nursery for the afternoon session (12.15 pm - 2.45 pm).
