2.	<p><u>Items for Meeting</u></p> <p>Session 2019 / 2020</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Number of children enrolled for next session is not looking good. Currently 117 4 short of that needed to support current staff level • It is likely that School will lose one teacher and all classes will become composite • Nursery is at capacity and currently requests are being turned down. <p>PSA Allocation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The council are restructuring provision for next session and the allocation for Beauly is not known. <p>New School</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Following a meeting with Highland Council Robert Campbell (Estate Strategy Manager) and John Finlayson (Chair of care, learning and housing committee) The council intend to proceed with planning application for Phase 1 of the New School in Beauly • Phase 1 was to incorporate Increased nursery capacity. A replacement canteen and Gym Hall • There is currently no information about the prospects or funding availability for Phase 2 <p>HMIe Inspection</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Week beginning 13th may the school will be subjected to an Inspection • 3 Inspectors will visit the school • Inspectors will visit all classes including the nursery and will interview teachers, parents and children • Tuesday 14th will be set aside for interviews with Parents, Parent Council and Pupil Council 	

	<p>Lagganlia 2020</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The cost has been assessed as £310 per child • There will be additional Transport costs to be born by the School • Parent Council have previously agreed to continue to subsidise the trip paying £60 per child leaving a cost to parents this year of £250 per child 	
3.	<p><u>Treasurers Report</u></p> <p>Current Balance - £4417.55</p> <p>These funds are committed in part to cover lagganlia contributions and to enable this years Panto trip.</p>
